Beginning (a/k/a Open Water) Scuba Classes Schedules & Important Information



- The class fee includes: All class materials, pool , Five training dives & certification fees. To register for class you must pay for class directly to AO.
- All students must review their Medical Info with our Staff member to THEN receive their Online E-Learning sign-up code from us and then register Online at www.AODIVE.com Set up your student profile on-line and upload your photo to your profile page, then complete the course and pass the Final Exam. All this must be done BEFORE the first class (pool). All students must print their Student Report (not certificate) & bring all the printed pages to your pool session. *You cannot proceed with your pool class without bringing the Student Report Report to your first class at Aquatic Obsessions and please be on time.
- The following equipment is provided by Aquatic Obsessions for you use, during your class:
Tanks and Air fills, Regulator w/Octopus, Dive Computer, Gauges and Bouyancy Compensator Devise (BCD). You must provide your own Personal Skin Gear. This gear must be of SCUBA QUALITY. If you do not get this gear from us, you must bring it to the dive shop a few days before your pool session to have checked to make sure it is of Scuba Quality and is safe. You will need: Scuba Mask & Snorkel, Ankle-high Booties, Fins, Wetsuit (Full 3mm), Gloves & Weights.

- Weekend classes, 8am-6pm, meet at the dive shop & bring snacks & drinks for the day) Please be on time for all classes and your dives.
- Evening classes, 6:30pm-10pm at the dive shop. Late arrivals for ALL Dive trips and Classes cannot jump into class or dive that has already started.
- All Training Dive Trip Fees, must be paid in full when you pay for class.
- Dive Dates and Times can be re-scheduled by A.O. due to bad weather or dive charter conflicts. Cancellations by the customer for training dives fees will receive a 50% refund, only if requested in writing by the student at least 30 days prior to the start date of the training dive trip (only emails to info@aodive.com constitutes written notice). NO-Show for the dive Trip results in forfeiture of all hotel and boat trip fees paid. Cancellation policies are products of the dive charters and hotels, not A,O.
- Any cancellation or movement request by the student to a different pool session less than 14 days prior to scheduled pool session will incur a \$50 re-scheduling fee, for each student. NO-Shows or cancellation within 24 hours of class, will result in a \$100 fee to re-schedule the pool. Please plan accordingly. We reserve the right to move students to another class if the class does not reach the minimum size by the week of the first class.
- Each student must attend his/her scheduled classes and training dives and must pass all SDI training & safety requirements to qualify for certification. All class graduates must also attend the AO Dive Club meeting that follows their training dives to be awarded with their SDI International OW Scuba OW certification card.
